## Course Q25/8 - Chilham

**Start** east of Molash on the A252 at the corner post of Northwood House at lane entrance (TR032521). **Proceed** on A252 and then the A28 to Milton Manor RAB, Thanington (6.726 miles). Turn and retrace on A28 via Chilham fork where bear left (EXTREME CARE) to turn at Spearpoint Corner RAB, Kennington (17.126 miles). **Turn**, retrace to Chilham fork, where left to rejoin A252. Proceed westwards to **Finish** approximately 290 yards past Chilham Castle Keep entrance (TQ 063534).
