## COMPETITORS NOTES

### Course Hazard Information

From start to first junction: the road is in poor condition with very uneven road surface and holes.

Brenzett RAB (Shell Garage): the road is deeply grooved and holed.

Between Brenzett roundabout and Brooklands roundabout there is a railway crossing (seldomly used). Be aware.

Between Brenzett roundabout and Brooklands roundabout after the railway crossing there may be a Boot Fair in progress with motor vehicles using the entrance/exit. Please be aware of this additional hazard.

1. Competitors must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.
2. In the interest of safety, you must wear recognised protective headgear that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. CTT Regulations state that **ALL** riders **MUST** wear such headgear.
3. A **WORKING** front and rear light, either flashing or constant, **MUST** be fitted to the machine at the start of the event in accordance with CTT Regulations.
4. Parking is **not permitted within 25 metres of the start** or at the finish.
5. Riders must not warm up on the course after the start of the event.
6. It would be appreciated if riders do not wear shoe plates in the HQ.
7. Numbers should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear.
8. Riders who use an inhaler for medical reasons (asthma etc.) should register the fact with British Cycling to satisfy UCI, CTT and BC anti-doping regulations.
9. Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations, disciplinary action may result from any breaches in these regulations.

**EVENT HQ** – Ham Street Sports Pavilion, Ham Street, Ashford, Kent TN26 2JH, should be open from around 06:00. Be aware of the height barrier at the entrance to the car park!

### SIGNING ON

Parking spaces are not allocated – Please, park as quickly and quietly as possible.

Once parked, go to the first floor in the pavilion, sign on and collect your race number; know your number.

A toilet/ changing facility are available for use downstairs.

Turbo warmups are permitted as long as you can respect current rules and do not disturb local residents.

**HQ TO THE START** - Turn right out of the car park and continue along road towards the start.

### AT THE END OF THE RACE

Remember you must return to the event HQ as soon as possible, even if DNF, to sign out, return your number and check to see if you are required for **DOPING CONTROL**. **Failure to sign out WILL result in DNF.**

Refreshments will be self-service. Downstairs in the pavilion kitchen there is a hot water machine that can be used to make tea/coffee. Some homemade cakes will be available. Any donations will be greatly appreciated.

## RESULTS

Do not approach the timekeeper after finishing.

Provisional results will available upstairs in the pavilion as soon as they are received from the timekeepers  
Prizes will be awarded as soon as the results have been verified.

### Course Q10/50

**START** (TR 00373 32756) Start on minor road out from Hamstreet towards the A2070 (Johnson's Corner) at a point 93 yards (85 metres) north of High Voltage power lines crossing the road at paint mark on road. Proceed to Johnsons Corner to join A2070 (0.66miles) (M) and turn left towards Brenzett RAB. **STRAIGHT OVER** at the Brenzett RAB(3xM) (4.03 mls) by taking the 2nd exit on to the A259 to **BROOKLAND ROUNABOUT. TURN** and retrace northwards on the A259 towards **Brenzett RAB. STRAIGHT OVER** (2ND exit), towards Johnson's Corner. **FINISH** opposite GIVE WAY signpost in Ham Mill Lane south of Johnsons Corner on the A2070. (TR 00243 31667) (10 miles)
