COMPETITORS NOTES

Covid-19 is still around and the CTT still have some guidance in place as follows:

Competitors or officials should consider not attending if they feel ill in ANY way especially if they, or family members have any CV19 symptoms. Anyone where the above present is encouraged to undertake a lateral flow test prior to attending the event. If the Test is Positive you should not attend the event.

1. **ALL** riders wear recognised protective headgear that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
2. **WORKING** front and rear lights, either flashing or constant, **MUST** be fitted to the machine at the start.
3. Parking is **not permitted in the vicinity of the start or finish**.
4. The start is about 3 miles from the event HQ, allow yourself at least 15 minutes to ride there.
5. Riders must not warm up on the course after the start.
6. It would be appreciated if riders do not wear shoe plates in the HQ.
7. Numbers will be at the HQ and issued at signing on.
8. Numbers should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear.
9. Riders who use an inhaler for medical reasons (asthma etc.) should register the fact with British Cycling to satisfy UCI, CTT and BC anti-doping regulations.
10. Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations, disqualification and disciplinary action may result from any breaches in these regulations.

SIGNING ON

Parking spaces are limited at the village hall - please park responsibly if you park on the road. Once parked, go into the hall, sign on and collect your race number.

Turbo warmups are permitted in the car park.

HQ TO THE START

Turn right out of the Village Hall car park and continue straight ahead to the A228 then turn left towards Grain village where you will find the start on the right.

In previous years many riders have driven from the village Hall to Power Station Road, a turning on the right about a mile beyond the start.

PLEASE BE AWARE

If you are riding to the start, or from the finish to the village hall, you will be riding on the course and competitors may already, or still be racing. BE CONSIDERATE!

AT THE END OF THE RACE

Remember you must return to the event HQ as soon as possible, even if DNF, to sign out, return your number and check to see if you are required for **DOPING CONTROL**. Failure to sign out **WILL result in DNF**.

RESULTS

Do not approach the timekeeper after finishing.

Results will be available on the day and will be published as soon as possible.

You are encouraged to stay for the prize giving.

COURSE DETAILS

Grain - Fenn Corner – Grain

Start on A.228 west of Grain village 14 metres north of the lamppost GFY26 on the Strood bound carriageway, by a minor access road to the National Grid site, where the continuous white edge of carriageway line starts. Proceed west on the A@@* to turn at Fenn Corner RAB (5.07 miles) (M). retrace on the A228 to finish directly opposite the lamppost GFY19 situated on the Strood bound carriageway. (10 miles)

PLEASE BE AWARE

The road on either side, and at the level crossing has numerous pot holes, have a good look as you go to the start.

Approaching the Fenn Corner RAB consider moving to the centre of the road if it is safe to do so.

Cars are known to attempt to overtake then turn left.
