COURSE DETAILS - Q10/19

Start on A26 one mile south of Tonbridge, at kerb point 50 yards north of Marbledon and 10 ft past 40 mph speed limit signs (TQ580445). Proceed north to take first left to join the A21 northbound. Proceed on A21, left on slip road to the Weald RAB, using the left hand side of the carriageway(5.4 miles). Encircle the roundabout and retrace on the A21 southbound, to finish at the leading edge of the last bridge before the A26 slip road (TQ 575451).

Course Notes:

- Riders should not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before their allotted start
- Warming up on the course is forbidden once the event has started
- Riders risk disqualification if they perform U-turns in the start or finish areas or use these areas as a public toilet
- Good luck and enjoy your ride

Event HQ: Bidborough Village Hall

Hall parking spaces are for event organisers, timekeepers and helpers only

Competitors: Please only park along the north side of Bidborough Ridge, with gaps between blocks of 5 vehicles to allow passing places for through traffic

NOTES

1. The threat of Covid-19 and the risk of infection does still remain. If you are feeling unwell or showing signs of Covid-19, then please do not attend any CTT event. Risk assessment can be found here – <https://legacy.cyclingtimetrials.org.uk/documents/index/covid-19>
2. Signing on will be available in the HQ from 06:00
3. Numbers will be at the HQ - NOT at the start. You **MUST** sign on !!
4. All competitors in open (Type A) events are required to return to the event HQ, hand in their number(s) and SIGN OUT. No sign out, no result.
5. A working white front and red rear light, either flashing or constant, must be fitted to the machine in a position visible to other road users, and is active whilst the machine is in use.
6. All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction and must comply to a recognised standard – see CTT Regulations/15 Protective Helmets for more details.
7. Your number must be correctly placed and visible from the rear when in your normal riding position, in line with CTT Regulations.
8. When competing on road bikes, the rider must not use tri-bars, wheels deeper than 90cm, aero helmets with visors. Skin suits are permitted.
9. No vehicles associated with competitors are to stop, load or unload riders within 300 yards of the start timekeeper, or on verges between the finish and the A26
10. No bicycles and/or cycling shoes with shoe plates to be allowed in the hall.
11. No use of turbos allowed in the hall or village of Bidborough.
12. Your number may be exchanged for a cup of tea or coffee after the event

Route from HQ to the start: Turn left/East out of the hall car park on Bidborough Ridge (B2176) to the T Jn with London Road/A26 (0.8m). Turn left to the start (0.3m), or right to warm-up prior to reporting at the start.

When passing the finish line, return to the HQ via the steep A26 access slip road, past the start area, then turning right on the B2176/Bidborough Ridge.
