COMPETITORS NOTES

Course Hazard Information

At the end of the road from the start you turn left onto A299 slip road: The road surface is not the best at this turn – TAKE CARE

Along the slip road there is a 'tram line' where the road surfaces join, be aware of this and avoid the 'tram line'.

At the end of the slip road there is a small part of road surface that is free from imperfections and makes a suitable joining point onto the main carriageway – TAKE CARE

1. Please make sure you know and understand the course Q10/30
2. Competitors must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.
3. In the interest of safety, you must wear recognised protective headgear that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. CTT Regulations state that **ALL** riders **MUST** wear such headgear.
4. A **WORKING** front and rear light, either flashing or constant, **MUST** be fitted to the machine at the start of the event in accordance with CTT Regulations.
5. Parking is **not permitted within 25 metres of the start** or at the finish.
6. Riders must not warm up on the course after the start of the event.
7. Pushing off is available, if you don't want it, politely decline.
8. It would be appreciated if riders do not wear shoe plates in the HQ.
9. Numbers should be centrally positioned below the waist to be clearly visible from the rear.
10. Riders who use an inhaler for medical reasons (asthma etc.) should register the fact with British Cycling to satisfy UCI, CTT and BC anti-doping regulations.
11. Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Cycle Racing on the Highways Regulations 1960 and CTT Rules and Regulations, disciplinary action may result from any breaches in these regulations.

EVENT HQ – St Bartholomew's Church Hall, King Edward Road, Herne Bay, Kent. CT6 6EB should be open from around 06:00.

SIGNING ON – this will be in the hall once opened.

HQ TO THE START — It's 1.5 miles to the start. Turn left out of King Edward Ave onto Mickleburgh Hill, follow the road until it takes you across Blacksole bridge onto Margate Rd, this will lead you to the roundabout to gain access to the Thanet Way A299. Continue along Thanet Way for about 0.5 miles then take the slip road for Reculver and turn left onto Sweechbrigde Road (Hawthorn Corner) where you will find the start.

COURSE Q10/30 Hawthorn Corner, Reculver - Monkton.

Start at eastern end of 1st drain in May Street, just before entrance to Southern Water Services Depot. (TR208673). Proceed via service road to join A299, continue on A299 to St. Nicholas at Wade RAB, take 3rd exit to Monkton RAB (5.472 miles). Turn and retrace A299 to finish west of the Roman Galley PH on slip road to Chislet 4 yards before last lamp post FUFV010 before turning left on slip road. (TR225676)

AT THE END OF THE RACE

Remember you must return to the event HQ as soon as possible, even if DNF, to sign out, return your number and check to see if you are required for **DOPING CONTROL**. Failure to sign out **WILL result in DNF**. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

Refreshments and some homemade cakes will be available. Any donations will be greatly appreciated.

Do not approach the timekeeper after finishing.
